

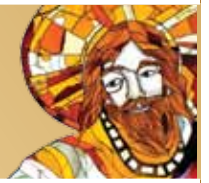

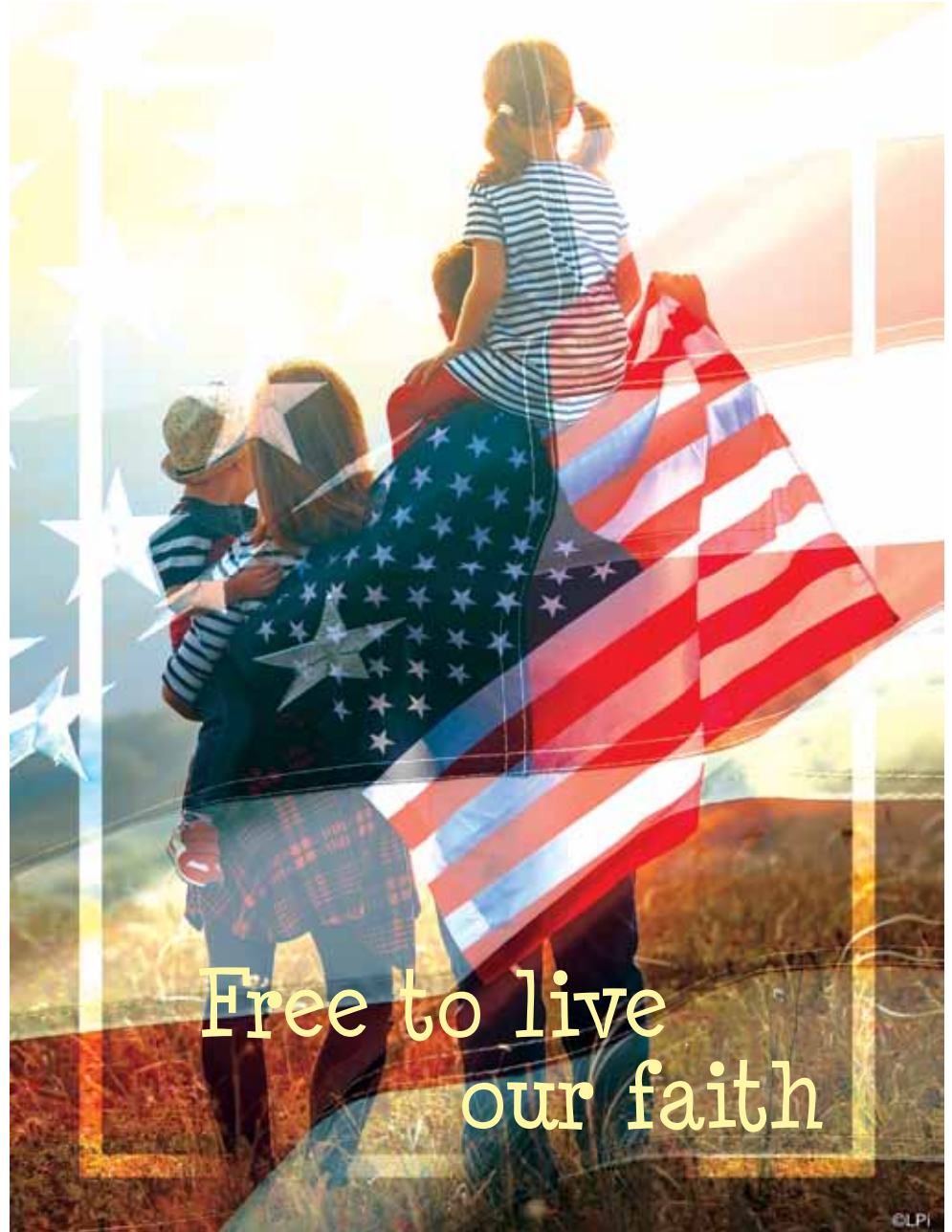

Our new Parochial Vicar (associate pastor) arrives this week. You can read more about Father Pius (and he'll respond to "Father Pius" or "Father Wesonga") in the next column, but suffice to say he has been in the US for the last eight years, ministering to a parish in Puerto Rico. We'll officially welcome him at next weekend's Masses, including treats in the narthex after all Masses.

Our carpet replacement throughout the school has begun, and on display this week in the Narthex are swatches of both the old and the new, to see what an improvement this will be for the spaces. I again thank those who have contributed to our efforts. The total cost for the project is \$210,000, and we currently have just over \$186,831, or 89% collected. THE ASSOCIATE PASTOR'S PEN

A note from our new Associate Pastor coming July 1!

My name is Father Pius Wesonga, AJ and I was born and raised in Uganda, East Africa, the country that is at the source of the Nile. I am the third child in a family of four girls and five boys, and grew up with 16 nieces and nephews. Both of my parents, Alphonse and Luliana, are living.

I am a religious missionary priest belonging to the Institute of the Apostles of Jesus (AJ). I responded to the call to the priesthood early in life. After my First Holy Communion, I was inspired by my grandfather to learn how to be an altar server. Beginning at 14 years of age, I attended minor seminary, secondary school, and major seminary for Philosophical and Theological studies, all within the Apostles of Jesus institutes. My first Religious Vows were in June 1996 and Final Vows in August 22, 2000. I was ordained to the diaconate on December, 2000 and to the priesthood on August 9, 2001. I have been with the Apostles of Jesus for about 30 years.

My seminary experience included intense prayer, study and work. It was such a wonderful time of learning and interacting with fellow seminarians and people from different cultural backgrounds. This experience helps me a lot when encountering people of other cultures in my apostolate.

My early years of priestly ministry were in parishes in Mombasa and Nairobi in Kenya. Then I worked as Communication Secretary for my order, teacher and formator in our major seminary. For the last eight years, I have been in San Juan, Puerto Rico. My hobby is walking. My inspirational scripture verse is John 3:16, "For God so loved the world, that He gave his only begotten Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish, but have everlasting life."

I am excited that soon I will be part of this wonderful family parish of Saint Thomas More, working alongside our lovely Pastor Father Justin and with our staff and parishioners, serving the larger community.
