

Father Aloysius Kasoma, from Masaka Diocese in Uganda is raising funds to build a classroom block for 200 students for their Catholic secondary school of 660 students. It is located in a rural area where the people are peasant farmers who consume what they grow. They have contributed the land on which the classroom block is going to be built and will provide the unskilled labor required in the construction of the building.
