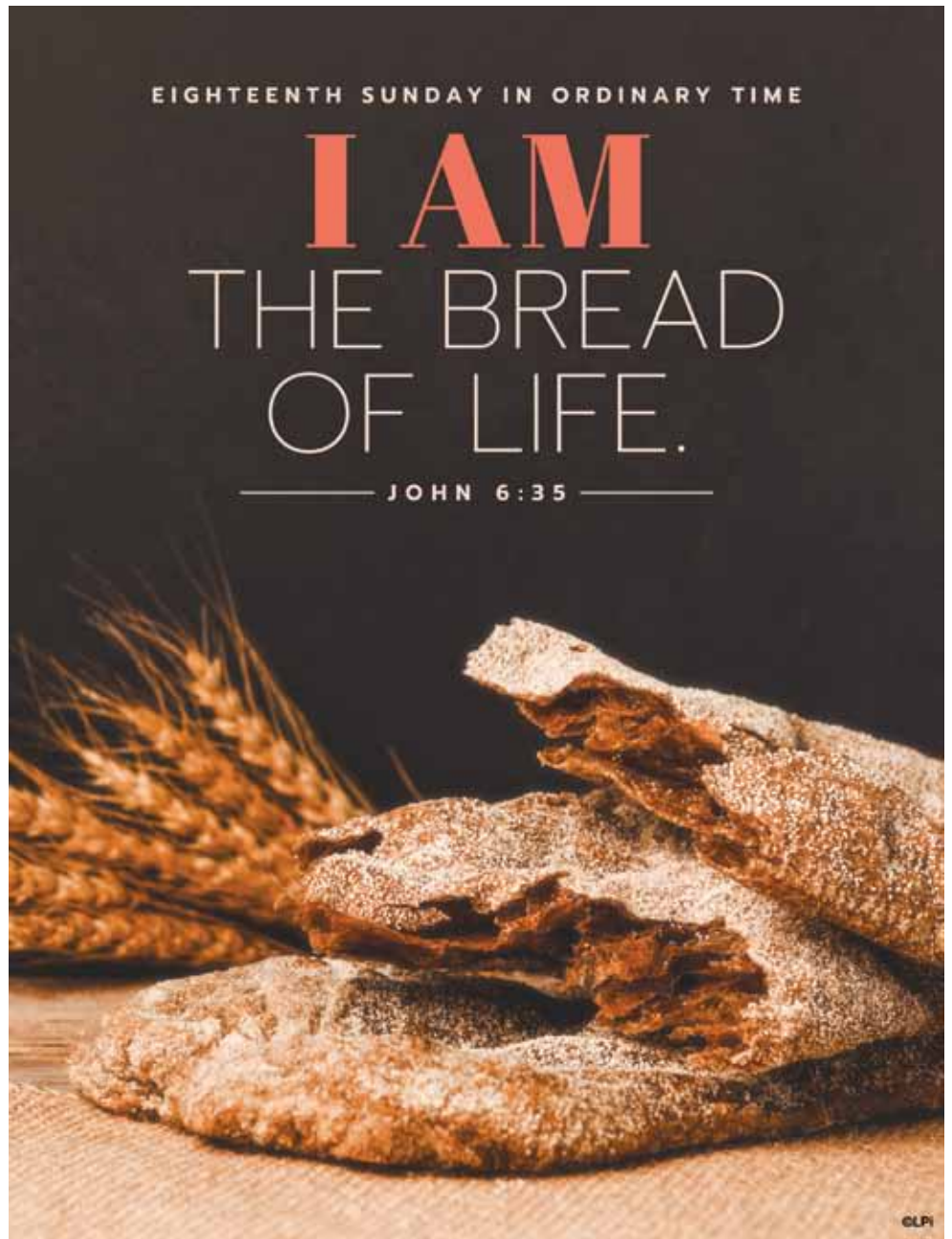

Faithful People of Saint Thomas More,

Thank you to all those who brought in supplies, organized, and helped sort and deliver items for our annual back to school drive, benefiting Seton Center families. See page 4 for details on this year's collection.

Also, a BIG thank you to the overwhelming generosity of parishioners, gifting over \$80,000 toward this year's Missionary Plan of Cooperation. Those funds surpass the \$70K goal to expand a secondary school in the Diocese of Masaka, Uganda.

We are just over two weeks away from the beginning of the academic year at STM School! Our summer projects made throughout the school over the summer continue in this final stretch, and we'll have photos and reports soon of our many investments.

One such project is a new roof on the school. We've been working with the diocese, insurers and contractors for many months to address hail damage, and work began this week.

Lastly, our annual Financial Report, which includes both a review of the just-concluded fiscal year and our budget for 2024-25, is now available on our website and in the parish office.

While we ran at a loss last year, this is due to the \$500,000 we spent on new energy-efficient HVAC replacements in the church and school. (We only brought in an extra \$200K to cover those expenses. The good news is that our energy bills continue to go down with these improvements, and we only have a handful of antiquated units in the school, left to replace

- Create an active account at virtus.org.
- Submit to a background check.
- Commit to the policy on Ethics & Integrity in Ministry (EIM).
- Attend an in-person Protecting God's Children Training (PGC).
- Complete an online Mandated Reporter training and submit a certificate of completion to Joan Sandford or Tracy Stewart for that training. (The Virtus site will take you to protectmokids.com.)

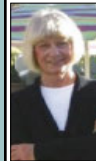
