THE PASTOR'S PEN

Faithful People of Saint Thomas More,

Next weekend is the annual second collection for Tomorrow's Priests, providing funding for the formation of our diocesan seminarians. It's an occasion to note some vocation-themed news at STM:

We received word last week that Deacon Tyrone Gutierrez, who was assigned to STM when he was newly ordained (2014), will be reassigned to STM beginning this week. He's spent the last several years working at Our Lady of Sorrows, Guardian Angels, and most recently at Holy Spirit. Dcn. Tyrone will help with a number of sacramental demands - baptisms, graveside, and Eucharistic reposition, along with assisting at Sunday Masses. Please join me in welcoming him back!

Next weekend is the ordination to the Transitional Diaconate for Seminarian Dan Stumpf, who was assigned to STM last summer. Dan's ordination will take place on Saturday, May 17th at 10AM, at the Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception. In addition, the diocese will celebrate the priesthood ordination of Dcn. Ethan Osborn the following weekend, at the Cathedral in St. Joseph.

If you have not done so yet, I encourage our families to participate in our Vocation Committee's Easter offering of the Vocations Crucifix. A Crucifix is distributed at each of our weekend Masses, inviting participants to pray for a culture of Vocations at STM. (Participants can sign up online at stmkc.com).

Lastly, many are unaware that one of our parishioners, Jacob Duerr, has been accepted into our seminary system, beginning this fall. Know that your contributions to next weekend's second collection will help to find one of our own, along with the future priests who will be serving Saint Thomas More!

Retrouvaille begins with an immersion weekend led by three couples. The couples then take part in 12 twohour follow-up sessions that delve deeper into concepts introduced on the weekend.

Ponder and Pray:

* When stress or troubles arise, how do you typically respond?

* Stress can reveal what we value most. What has recent stress in your life revealed about your priorities or trust in God?

* Do you see stress as a crushing weight or as a way that God strengthens you? Surrender your struggles to God, to draw you closer to him.

You Are Not Alone

Life is filled with stress, challenges, and times of great trouble. From school finals to health battles to major transitions, the weight of these moments can feel overwhelming. Yet, today's readings remind us of a deeper truth: We are never abandoned. In Revelation, John sees a vision of the saints who have "survived the time of great distress." Their survival isn't just physical—it's spiritual. They remain in God's hands, held by his love and strengthened by his presence.






