

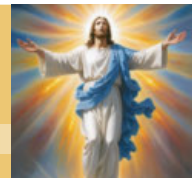

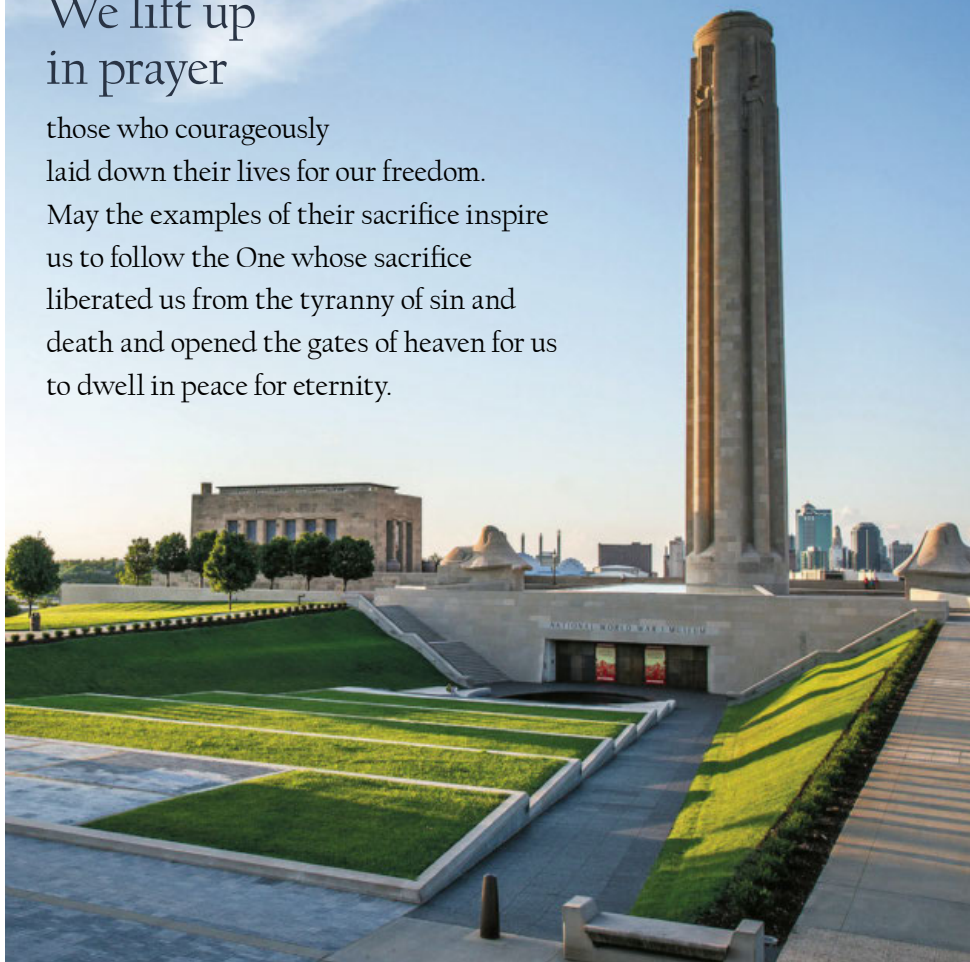

Faithful People of Saint Thomas More,

This is my last bulletin column before I depart this week for my sabbatical in Oregon. Father Paul Sappington will take on responsibilities as parish administrator beginning on Tuesday.

I want to thank the community for allowing me to accompany you these nine years as the 7th pastor. STM afforded me the chance to live with numerous seminarians and priests in the rectory, to stretch my homilistic skills away from tightly-constructed deliveries to more extemporaneous offerings, and to grow in the responsibilities of shepherding.

Within the first few months of arriving in 2016, Father Pat Rush, (STM's 3rd Pastor), asked how I was doing. My reply: "I'm learning new skill sets." And that was very, very true. Serving STM is challenging and often complicated, and the fruit born from the engagements has been meaningful and instructive. 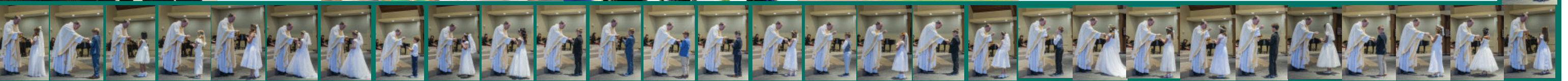
