ABOUT THE National Eucharistic Revival

The Bishops of the U.S. are calling for a three-year grassroots revival of devotion and belief in the Real Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist. The initiative will culminate in the first National Eucharistic Congress in the U.S. in almost fifty years, where almost 100,000 Catholics will join together in Indianapolis for a once-in-a-lifetime pilgrimage toward the “source and summit” of our Catholic faith.
