It is a time of discernment and reflection. It is a time to ask questions about one's life, and consider who God, in Jesus, calls us to be.

During the Inquiry Sessions, you are invited to....

- *Attend Mass weekly. Allow yourself to be in an environment that is rich in the movements that Catholics use to experience and encounter God.
- *Make regular examinations of your conscience. Reflect on how you have responded, or rejected, God's invitations in your life.
- *Develop moments of silence in your life. In silence, we can hear the voice of another more clearly, including the voice of God.
- *Nurture a spirit of gratitude. Trust in God's providence; that you have been led to this moment for a reason. Trust that God has blessings to bestow upon you as you discern God's presence in the Catholic Church.
