We are planning two new playgrounds:


- A fenced-in, safe space for our youngest children (ages 2–5)
- · A larger structure for our school-aged students to enjoy


Both playgrounds will feature zero-level entry and will be fully ADA compliant, creating a welcoming, inclusive space for all children — something our current equipment cannot offer.
